GENERAL ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

Minimum Admissions Requirements for Excel Middle School and High School Programs:

- When transferring high school credits to EHS, official high school transcripts are required; submit official transcripts to Excel High School, 601 Carlson Parkway, Suite 1250, Minnetonka, MN 55305, or email to registrar@excelhighschool.com.
- Students entering 6th grade (middle school) must be age 11 or older and have completed the 5th grade. Students entering 9th grade must be age 14+. To enroll in adult high school program you must be age 18+ and have not attended high school for at least 6 months.
- Students who require special needs programs, such as IEP or Special Education (Title I or Title II) Services, should contact the EHS Counseling Office prior to enrollment. There is room to be successful in this program. As an online school, Excel High School is unable to support IEP/Special Education Services.
- A current Government-issued photo ID is required for final exams and graduation.

Excel High School offers seven curriculum tracks to earn an accredited high school diploma:

- 1) Standard High School Curriculum (Ages 14-18)
- 2) Honors or Honors/AP Curriculum
- 3) AP/Honors Curriculum
- 4) CA A-G Curriculum
- 5) Adult High School Curriculum (Ages 18+ and not in high school for at least 6 months)
- 6) Summer School/Credit Recovery Individual Courses (Age 14+ for credit-bearing courses)
- 7) ACE Credit Courses

MIDDLE SCHOOL (AGES 11-14 / GRADES 6-8) DISCLOSURE

Middle School Fee Schedule: (Grades 6-8)

Payment Option:

Excel High School charges \$1,590 per school year, for middle school courses + online tutoring. The payments are made in full (\$1,590) per grade level or in 10-monthly interest-free installments of \$159. Tuition installment payments must be set up on autopay and are due monthly recurring until paid in full. Tuition includes access to TraintheBrain.com online tutoring.

- Early termination/cancellation for middle school is \$200; there will be no refund of installment payments already made to the school. A cancelation form must be submitted. There will be no records or transcripts provided with the early termination fee.
- Accounts that have not made payments for 60 days will be sent to collections.
- Middle school students may take up to 12 months to complete each grade level.
- The middle school (grades 6-8) program must be completed in 3-years or less.
- The cost for a one-time (per grade level), 2-month extension is \$200.
- *Transcripts/report cards are held until tuition is paid in full.

STANDARD CURRICULUM (Ages 14-18) DISCLOSURE

Traditional High School Fee Schedule: (Non-Adult / Students Ages 14-18) Monthly installment option:

Excel High School charges \$1,690 for full-time enrollment per grade level for the standard, accredited high school courses (non-adult) + online tutoring. The tuition covers up to six 2-semester courses. Payments for the standard high school are made either in full (\$1,690) per grade level or in 10-monthly interest-free installments of \$169.00. Tuition installment payments must be set up on autopay and are due on the monthly due date and on a recurring monthly basis until all payments are made in full. Students opting for the monthly installment plan must agree to the auto-pay debit requirement. Excel High School offers standard high school as one grade level (equivalent to two semesters). Tuition includes access to TraintheBrain.com online tutoring.

*Optional enhanced dedicated success coaching service, called Success Coach Pro is an additional \$1000 per grade level, made in 4 payments of \$250 each.

- Early termination/cancellation for the traditional high school is \$200; there will be no refund of installment payments already made to the school. A cancelation form must be submitted. There will be no records or transcripts provided with the early termination fee.
- Accounts that have not made payments for 60 days will be sent to collections.
- Traditional (standard) high school students may take up to 12 months to complete each grade level. The traditional high school (non-adult) program must be completed in 48 months or less.
- *Diplomas and transcripts are held until tuition is paid in full.
- The cost for a one-time (per grade level), 2-month extension is \$200.

HONORS CURRICULUM (Ages 14-18 / Non-Adult) DISCLOSURE

Honors High School Fee Schedule:

Payment Option:

Excel High School charges \$1890 per grade level for the accredited Honors high school courses (non-adult) + online tutoring. The payments are made in full (\$1890) or in 10-monthly interest-free installments of \$189 per grade level. Tuition is auto-billed and is due monthly and on a recurring monthly basis until paid in full. Tuition includes access to TraintheBrain.com online tutoring.

There are two semesters for each grade level. 12 months is given for each grade level.

- *Diplomas and transcripts are held until tuition is paid in full.
- The cost for a one-time (per grade level), 2-month extension is \$200.
- Accounts that have not made payments for 60 days will be sent to collections.
- The early termination/cancellation fee for the Honors high school program is \$200.
 There will be no refunds for installment payments already made. A cancelation form
 must be submitted. There will be no records or transcripts provided with the early
 termination fee.

AP/HONORS CURRICULUM (Ages 14-18 / Non-Adult) DISCLOSURE

AP/Honors High School Fee Schedule:

Payment Option:

Excel High School charges \$2690 per grade level for the accredited Honors high school courses (non-adult) + online tutoring. The payments are made in full (\$2690) or in 10-monthly interest-free installments of \$269 per grade level. Tuition is auto-billed and is due monthly and on a recurring monthly basis until paid in full. Tuition includes access to TraintheBrain.com online tutoring.

There are two semesters for each grade level. 10 months is given for each grade level.

- Early termination/cancellation for AP/Honors school is \$200; there will be no refund
 of installment payments already made to the school. A cancelation form must be
 submitted. There will be no records or transcripts provided with the early
 termination fee.
- Accounts that have not made payments for 60 days will be sent to collections.
- The cost for a one-time (per grade level), 2-month extension is \$200.
- *Transcripts/report cards are held until tuition is paid in full.

CA A-G HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM (Ages 14-18 / Non-Adult) DISCLOSURE

CA A-G High School Fee Schedule:

Payment Option:

Excel High School charges \$1890 per grade level for the accredited Honors high school courses (non-adult) + online tutoring.

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The payments are made in full (\$1890) or in 10-monthly interest-free installments of \$189 per grade level. Tuition is auto-billed and is due monthly and on a recurring monthly basis until paid in full. Tuition includes access to TraintheBrain.com online tutoring.

There are two semesters for each grade level. 12 months is given for each grade level.

- Early termination/cancellation for CA A-G students is \$200; there will be no refund of installment payments already made to the school. A cancelation form must be submitted. There will be no records or transcripts provided with the early termination fee.
- Accounts that have not made payments for 60 days will be sent to collections.
- The cost for a one-time (per grade level), 2-month extension is \$200.
- *Transcripts/report cards are held until tuition is paid in full.

ADULT HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM (Ages 18+ and not in high school for at least 6 months) DISCLOSURE

Adult High School Fee Schedule:

Payment Option:

Excel High School charges \$99.90 per month for the accredited adult high school diploma program. The payment structure is \$99.90 per month for 10 months, or less, depending upon how many months it takes a student to successfully complete 21.5 credits and graduate. For example, if a student completes the adult high school diploma program and graduates in 5 months, the total cost would be \$99.90 x 5 = \$499.50. Excel reduces the cost of the program for those students that complete it sooner than 10 months.

Adult high school students may take up to 12 months to complete each grade level (approximately six courses). Enrollment is month to month, and adult students may cancel at any time; however, there will be **no** refund of installment payments already made.

Should there be no cancelation, re-enrollment will be one late payment, a late fee, and a current month's tuition (\$209.80).

The payments are made in full (\$999) or by making ten interest-free monthly installments to the school. Adult students may choose to pay in full at (\$999) or may choose to make ten monthly installments of \$99.90 per month.

Payments are directly billed to the credit/debit card on file with the school. The adult, high school program, must be completed in 48 months or less, and students are expected to stay actively engaged in their courses.

If a student is paid in full (\$999) and is locked out for inactivity, the student will be subject to a re-enrollment fee of \$200.00 and courses may start over from the very beginning.

- After 10 months, the account is paid in full (assuming no extenuating circumstances).
- *Diplomas and transcripts are held until tuition and fees are paid in full.
- The cost for a one-time extension is \$200, payable in full.

SUMMER SCHOOL/CREDIT RECOVERY/SINGLE COURSE FEE SCHEDULE

- Standard single middle and high school courses are \$225 each for either a onesemester or two-semester course
- ACE College Credits are \$249 and must be completed in 4-months. *One Extension is available
- EHS Honors courses are \$325 for 1.0 credit (2 semesters)
- AP courses are \$599 for 1.0 credit (2 semesters)
- CA A-G courses \$325 for 1.0 credit/10 CA credits (2 semesters)
- Middle School Single Course \$225 (one full year course)
- Summer School and Credit Recovery courses are valid for 6 months from the date of enrollment.
- To enroll in credit-bearing courses you must be at least 14 years old.
- Students have 6-months to complete the program.

ACE COLLEGE CREDITS must be completed in 4 months.

Students must participate in accordance with Excel's participation policy. Excel High School does not offer an installment plan for ACE/Credit Recovery/Summer School single courses. Please see https://www.excelhighschool.com/courses_php, for a complete list of courses available.

*No refunds after 10 calendar days from purchase.

ACE CREDITS (Grades 11 & 12, adult & standard aged students) DISCLOSURE

- Excel High School charges \$249 per ACE course, this is paid in full upon enrolling.
- ACE courses must be completed in 4 months, a one-time, 60 day, \$200 extension is available.
- ACE courses tuition will be on top of the program fee tuition.
- NO refunds 10 calendar days after the enrollment date.
- Transfer of credit is always up to the receiving institution. Excel High School cannot guarantee the transferability of the ACE courses and it will be up to the student to find out from their chosen institution.

TRAIN THE BRAIN LIVE ON-DEMAND TUTORING

Train The Brain offers live, on-demand tutoring available with most programs at no cost to the student. If you select a program that does not include Train The Brain tutoring, you may purchase tutoring services for \$75.00 per month on a monthly auto-renew subscription, which is billed month to month and may be canceled anytime. Cancelation must be done before the monthly billing date, as no payments will be refunded. Excel High School is unable to refund the tutoring subscription.

TUITION, FEES, AND PAYMENTS

Tuition Payment Schedule (Auto Payment), Late Fees, and Chargebacks

- As per the enrollment agreement, tuition is auto-billed to the credit/debit card on file each month if not paid in full upon enrollment. Students must participate in the auto-billing option to remain enrolled at Excel High School unless the tuition is paid in full upon enrollment.
- Accounts two installments past due are subject to termination and sent to a licensed collections agency.
- Late Charge: If your monthly payment is 5+ days past due, you will be charged a \$10 late fee. Students demonstrating a pattern of missed payments will be subject to termination of payment plans. After a third missed monthly installment payment, any tuition balance will be due in full, and Excel will no longer extend installment options.
- Chargebacks: Student accounts with a bank dispute (chargebacks) will incur a \$50 fee per chargeback, and collections fees, and the account will be sent to collections. Accounts with chargebacks are not eligible for an installment plan with Excel High School. Any outstanding tuition is due in full. Chargebacks may make you ineligible for enrollment.

TUITION, FEES, AND PAYMENTS

The standard high school diploma program consists of two (2) semesters per grade level. We also offer a summer semester. Each semester consists of 5 or 6 courses of .5 or 1.0 credit each for a total of 21.5 or 24 credits needed to graduate. The above-stated price may be paid in full or per month and includes all registration and admission fees.

These fees are non-refundable after ten (10) calendar days following the date of enrollment.

Estimated Total Program Price: If an adult student completes their entire diploma with Excel High School, it is estimated that the total program cost will be \$999 or less, including tuition, registration, and other fees if the student is actively engaged in the program, making progress, and earning credits. If a student is paid in full (\$999) and is locked out for inactivity, the student will be subject to a re-enrollment fee of \$200.00 and courses may start over from the very beginning.

Estimated Total Program Price: If a traditional standard high school student (non-adult) completes his or her entire grade 9-12 standard diploma with Excel High School, it is estimated that the 4-year program cost will be \$6,760, including tuition and all fees. The total program cost is an estimate and may be less depending on how many credits transfer to Excel High School, the program you select, and changes made at the discretion of Excel High School due to reasonable changes in tuition, fees, and other charges. Cost may be reduced by transfer credits and other promotions and discounts.

For any check, draft, or money order that is returned for insufficient funds (NSF), students will be charged a \$50 fee, and Excel High School will resubmit for payment.

Chargebacks are subject to a \$50 bank fee per transaction.

Students are required to use the Auto Payment option. Students are responsible for keeping the account information up to date to avoid any late or returned payment penalties.

For any default not cleared within 10-days of notification of non-payment, Excel reserves the right to discontinue services, add any collection and/or attorney's fees, and the student will not be entitled to any refunds or re-enrollment.

Students in Canada and foreign countries will be responsible for payment of any applicable customs duties and additional shipping fees. Payments may be made in U.S. dollars only.

Early termination/cancellation may be subject to a \$200 cancellation fee, and there will be no refunds of installment payments already made.

Late Payments:

You will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 if your monthly payment is late by 5-days or more. Accounts past due 5+ days will be placed on lockout status. If you do not pay the overdue amount and late fee within 30-days, Excel High School reserves the right to suspend your enrollment in the program immediately and require you to pay the outstanding balance of the program price associated with the payment plan you chose. In addition, you will be responsible for any collection costs, including legal fees, incurred by Excel High School to collect the amounts owed.

Privacy:

Your enrollment and academic records will be protected in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

GRADUATION

High School Diploma Completion Time. The standard/honors (non-adult) high school diploma program can be completed in about 2-4 years (6-8 months per grade level); students are allowed a maximum of four (4) years from the date of enrollment to complete their program and 12 months per grade level.

Adult Fast Track Diploma Completion Time. The adult high school fast path diploma can be completed in 12-18 months or substantially sooner with transfer credits.

Transfer of Credits: You may be eligible to receive up to 16 transfer credits for high school courses you have already completed from an accredited school. Upon graduation, students will be awarded an official, accredited high school diploma. No assurance is made of eligibility for job placement.

Acceptance for transfer of academic credits is determined by the receiving institution. Since Excel High School is a regionally accredited institution. Most credits from Excel High School will be accepted by all public and private high schools. Excel High School's accreditation is recognized by all colleges, universities, employers, and the United States Military.

For complete details on graduation requirements, consult the School Catalog. **Students** are allowed 12 months per grade level for completion without paying an extension fee. A maximum of 4 years to complete the adult program is allowed.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Adult students may cancel or withdraw verbally by contacting a school representative at Excel High School at 800-620-3844 or using the online drop form, by fax at 1-952-465-3701, or in writing by US Mail, or issue a Help Desk Ticket. All other students must submit a cancelation form.
